2023 Grand Valley Water Users Association System Conservation Pilot Project (SCPP) - FORM A Instructions

- (1) Enter name of Individual who (if selected) will enter into a contract with the GVVUA. You may also list an entity as the "Farm Operator". Entities please also include the name of an individual with authority to sign a contract for the entity.
- (2) Enter the total irrigated acreage within the GVVUA service area under management of the Farm Operator during the 2022 irrigation season. You may be required to provide further documentation.
- (3) Enter the address of the farm headquarters. Include a mailing address if different from farm headquarters address.
- (4) Provide the phone number of the Farm Operator, cell phone is preferred.
- (5) Provide an active email address where the Farm Operator may be contacted.
- (6) Identify each field you would like entered into the lottery in a manner you recognize. For example: NE 40, Lower 15, etc. Fields will be assigned a unique ID if selected. Only list fields you are entering into the SCPP.
- (7) List approximate location of each field. For example: NE Corner of 17 and O Roads.
- (8) List the irrigated acres within each field (fields may be divided if the irrigation system allows for partial fallowing, list only the acres that will be a part of the program). Approximate as necessary, verification will be done based on acres irrigated in most recent NAIP aerial imagery.
- (9) List the serial # associated with the GVVUA delivery to the field.
- (10) Provide the USDA Farm Service Agency farm and tract number for the field. If no Farm and Tract Number exists mark "NA".
- (11) Enter the abbreviation (FF, WW, SS, SF) for the Program Activity for the field. See table below.

Program Activity	Fallow Period	Cooperator payment per acre
Full Fallow (FF)	Entire irrigation Season	\$1,306
Fallow Until October 1 (WW)	April 1 through Sept 30	\$1,237
Fallow Until September 1, (SS)	April 1 through Aug 31	\$1,073
Summer Fallow (SF)	May 15th through August 31	\$686

- (12) If a field is selected for the program the Farm Operator will be required to verify that you have had control for the previous 2 years using Farm Service Agency records.
- (13) A single entity may submit up to 3 applications. The total of all applications may not exceed 240 acres.
